Whether you have your personal IFR instructor onboard or you are matched with one, you will benefit from an IFR ground training program provided by a CFII professional volunteer.

A minimum of 8 teams is required

Itinerary: Discover Canada : Northern Regions (wilderness) or The Maritimes (varies every year) enjoy activities such as fishing, ATV expeditions, trekking, and great hospitality provided by locals at every visited destination.

Dates: last week of July beginning of August (Friday to Sunday)

Average accommodation cost per person dbl occupancy: 150\$ a day including meals

Aircraft registration: 450\$ - covers landing and parking fees, flight preparation and flight supervision as well as ground transportation.

Rental aircraft : average cost per hour: 100\$ - Cessna 172 – no minimum time required.
