



## GOVERNOR GENERAL'S CUP INTERNATIONAL AIR RALLY TERMS AND CONDITIONS

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**Terms and conditions of your participation to the Governor General's cup event presented at the time, organised and operated by International Air Rally:**

A [waiver of responsibility](#) will be submitted to each participant/person attending the event and must be signed prior to departure.

All information on the [www.airrally.com](http://www.airrally.com) website regarding travel programs, dates, prices, etc. is subject to change without notice.

International Air Rally, hereinafter called the “Operator” “promoter” assumes no responsibility for injury, death, damage, loss, or delay incurred by any person in connection with the journey organised in the context of the event he is participating in, by reason of any occurrence beyond the control of the Operator.

The Operator reserves the right to alter or to cancel the itinerary, to refuse to accept, or retain, any person(s) as tour participants when necessary for the comfort, convenience or safety of the participants attending the Governor General's cup event presented at the time.

### **Aircraft Insurance coverage needed for the Caribbean.**

Most insurance companies will cover the Caribbean. But you must check with your insurance company before departing.

### **Cancellation Policy:**

- **0\$ refund for aircraft registration fees**
- **Cancellation 30 days before departure:** 20% will be retained from team registration fee.
- **Cancellation 29 days before departure:** 50% will be retained from team registration fee
- **Cancellation 25 days before departure :** 100% will be retained from team registration fee

**However should participants find an unregistered replacement then fees can be transferred to new team..**

- **No Show before departure: 100% will be retained regardless of reason that caused the no show.**

Rooms are confirmed and assigned as payments are received. (1<sup>st</sup> come 1<sup>st</sup> served) Should payments be received late, we cannot guarantee that rooms will still be available at the hotel listed on the program. In that case, participants will be lodged at nearest available hotel according to availability. Late registered participants have so far been able to be accommodated. However availability is affected by time of year : high season period, or time of the week: week end

## **Recommendation:**

Pack lightly and in soft bags or small roller suitcases. Laundry services are available at all places with a 2-night stop. No formal wear is required. T-shirts will be provided in sufficient quantity for the whole journey and must be worn at all times except for evening functions.

Bring a cooler with a light lunch is recommended. Using frozen water bottles to keep it cool is a good idea.

Bug repellent, sun screen, disinfectant or after bite soothing cream are recommended

Running shoes are recommended for excursions

Cash is also recommended: destinations requiring cash will be listed on technical information package

## **IMPORTANT:**

### **➤ All participants must have valid ID documents (Passport required).**

Pilots must have with them:

1. Pilot License
2. Current Medical Certificate
3. Proof of aircraft insurance coverage
4. Airplane registration
5. Airplane Airworthiness Certificate
6. VISA B1-B2 for participants from overseas
7. US customs sticker (can be obtained at FXE customs office approx 25-30\$)

### **➤ Flight conditions:**

International Air Rally, the Operator, is not responsible for teams affected by delays, changes of itinerary, diversions. Teams must follow the program and schedule established by the International Air Rally Organizing Committee, unless safety is a reason for change of route. Pilot in command is the only designated person to make the decisions according to his/her flying confidence, qualifications and comfort. The PIC must not be influenced by others when it comes to securing the safety of himself and his crew. In case of bad weather ahead, departure can be delayed. However if an overnight stop is required the operator is not responsible for extra costs incurred.

### **➤ All for one and one for all: Camaraderie spirit, mutual assistance and team support play a major role in the success of the event. Our love for people and culture set the tone of every event.**

**The Governor General's Cup is a Flying event with an International reputation. The GGC is covered extensively every year by International media accompanying the participants in their journey. For that reason, it is MANDATORY that every participant wears the provided T-shirts every day from time of departure from the hotel to time of return to the hotel. T-shirts must be worn during any activity taking place during the day even if this activity does not imply any flying. Participants can change into other clothing in the evening, to the exception where a ceremony is taking place: ie. Award ceremony in every destination or at the finals.**

The group benefits from special services: customs handling, ground transport, activities, etc.. Participants not wearing the T-shirts will not receive the privileges acquired for the group. It is also a good way of not being left behind!!!

Each year since 2001, this event gathers teams from different countries. The success of the Rally relies on the team spirit and team's awareness of the character of this adventure and the acknowledgement of the efforts and hard work put into the organisation of this unique International aviation event. There is NO OTHER Flying event of this kind implicating such a large number of local volunteers and employees working in partnership with the organisation for the promotion of respective destinations and general aviation. Because of this, participants benefit from the highest levels of security and support provided at destination.

## ➤ **Equipment Rental**

The “operator” can help in providing sources for renting equipment including aircraft needed to undertake the journey planned for the Governor General’s Cup event.. The “Operator” can provide advice in price and condition negotiations with the owner of the equipment, however, the “Operator” is not responsible for any dispute or problems with rented or leased equipment , contracts or other agreements entered between the two parties. It is the renter’s entire responsibility to make sure he is in agreement with the terms and the conditions in which the product is rented. Any dispute is to be settled between the owner of the equipment and the person renting his equipment.

## ➤ **Volunteers involved insure the well being and safety of the pilots.**

They include: The IAR Organizing Committee, organizing committee of each and every visited destination including dignitaries, members of Provincial Governments, Mayors and city council in addition to the representatives of each airport as well as partners (corporations & others) who make this event possible.

As a demonstration of respect for the people involved in this ambitious undertaking and especially the destinations receiving **YOU**, each participant registered with in the Governor General’s cup event, is committing to follow the itinerary, the program established by the Organizing Committee from the beginning to end (subject to weather conditions and safety issues). Should any team decide to divert from the intended route for any other reason than mechanical, weather or health problem, the team will no longer be considered as part of the group.

The Organizing Committee reserves the right to disqualify (without refund) any team or member of a team representing a risk or major disturbance impacting the safety and the wellbeing of the group.

## ➤ **Sponsorship** A great way to promote your products and services while enjoying the company of other pilots and meeting potential clients in each and every destination.

**Sponsored teams:** International Air Rally, the “Operator & Promoter” will provide an invoice to team’s sponsor. Sponsor’s logos will be applied on sponsored team’s aircraft. Sponsor’s promotional wear such as T-shirts, caps, jackets can be worn to represent sponsors during evening receptions to the exception of the **award ceremonies during which Air Rally T-shirts must be worn for group picture taking and media.**

**Team Sponsor logo** will appear on the International Air Rally sponsors Rally page and the sponsors banner carried through and exposed during the event

## ➤ **Aviation Connection Mission**

International Air Rally is the promoter of Aviation Connection Governor General’s Cup event. The principal mission is to encourage Pilots to become Pilot mentors to young pilots on the way to becoming commercial pilots or private pilots. Governor General’s Cup organizing Committee crew offers every year the opportunity to a young commercial pilot to FLY the Governor General’s cup at no cost. Young pilot will FLY PIC and accumulate hours during the 12-15 day expenses paid. Aviation Connection whenever possible will gather a group of participating pilots to fly local kids when permitted at destination.

The Governor General’s Cup is a good opportunity to show the benefits of General Aviation and build a good sentiment of support across the continent and beyond.
